THE PRIVACY POLICY OF THIS WEBSITE

Object: *Information pursuant to EU Regulation no. 2016/679 and Legislative Decree n. 101 of 2018*

This page describes how to manage the website in relation to the processing of personal data of users who consult it.

Purpose of the treatment

and will be subject to treatment based on the principles of correctness, lawfulness, transparency and protection of your / your privacy and your / your rights.

Methods of treatment and conservation

The treatment of your personal data is carried out by means of the following operations: collection, registration, organization, structuring, storage, consultation, adaptation or modification, use, dissemination, communication, extraction, comparison, interconnection, limitation, cancellation and destruction of data.

Your personal data are subjected to both paper and electronic processing with logic strictly related to the purposes for which the personal data were collected and, in any case, in such a way as to guarantee the security of the same. The data are kept for the time strictly necessary for the management of the purposes for which the data are collected in compliance with current regulations and legal obligations. In any case O.N.I. OFFICINE NAVALI ITALIANE S.P.A. practice rules that prevent the retention of data indefinitely and therefore limits the storage time in compliance with the principle of minimization of data processing.

Scope of communication and dissemination

Your data may be made available for the purposes specified above to the following recipients:

- to companies or other third parties (professional firms, consultants, insurance companies for the provision of insurance services, suppliers, persons providing services for the management of the information system, etc.) who carry out outsourced activities on behalf of the Owner and who are formally appointed as Data Processors;
- public entities, for the fulfillment of legal obligations.

Without the need for its express consent, the Data Controller may communicate its data for the purposes set out in points 1 to 3 of the purposes of the treatment to supervisory bodies, judicial authorities, insurance companies for the provision of insurance services, and to those subjects to whom the communication is mandatory by law for the accomplishment of those purposes.

Consent

The provision of data and the related processing for the purposes referred to in paragraphs 1 to 3 of the purposes of the processing is necessary to guarantee the services of the Data Controller requested by you and to implement the requests made. In case of refusal, you will not be able to send requests successfully and will not receive feedback from the Owner.

The provision of data for the purposes referred to in point 4 of the purposes of processing is, however, optional.
